SUBJECT: STAFF NOTES

1. A TCC (Transportable Communications Center) was delivered by EUGA to FOB on November 29th. Its purpose is to act as a standby circuit should present land-line teletype become inoperative through accident or sabotage. The installation contains a radio teletype facility as well as a manual circuit. FOB is writing a Signal Plan for coordination with EUGA for future emergency use as well as for periodic checks of the equipment. The cipher equipment will be removed from the TCC and stored in FOB Sigcenter for security reasons. Antennas have been erected and successful test between FOB and LINER have been made.

2. Chief Comm Engineer, EUGA visited this week to discuss our requirements and to coordinate installation of permanent standby teletype circuit at MGB for joint use by FOB. He expects to complete the permanent installation within two months. At that time the TCC may be removed from FOB, if necessary, and this base would then utilize the installation at MGB in an emergency.

3. With the assignment of [ ] this office will make periodic monitoring checks of ZIPPER circuits from now on. [ ] has already discussed with ZIPPER his intention of requesting specific times and frequencies of active radio operators for monitoring purposes, and received assurances that such information would be given when requested. [ ] will also activate the Emergency Staff Circuit which checks in with LINER weekly.
