- l. A TCC (Transportable Gommmications Center) was delivered by EUCA to POB on November 29th. Its purpose is to act as a standby circuit should present landwline teletype become insperative through accident or sabetage. The installation contains a radio teletype facility as well as a manual circuit. POB is writing a Signal Plan for ecordination with EUCA for future emergency use as well as for periodic checks of the exament. The cipher equipment will be removed from the TCC and stored in POB Signanter for security reasons. Antennas have been erected and successful test between POB and LIMBER have been made.
- 2. Chief Gemme Engineer, ENGL visithis week to discuss our requirements and to coordinate installation, permanent standby teletype circuit at MOB for joint use by POB. He expects to complete the permanent installation within two months. At that time the TCC may be removed from POB, if necessary, and this base would then utilize the installation at MOB in an emergency.
